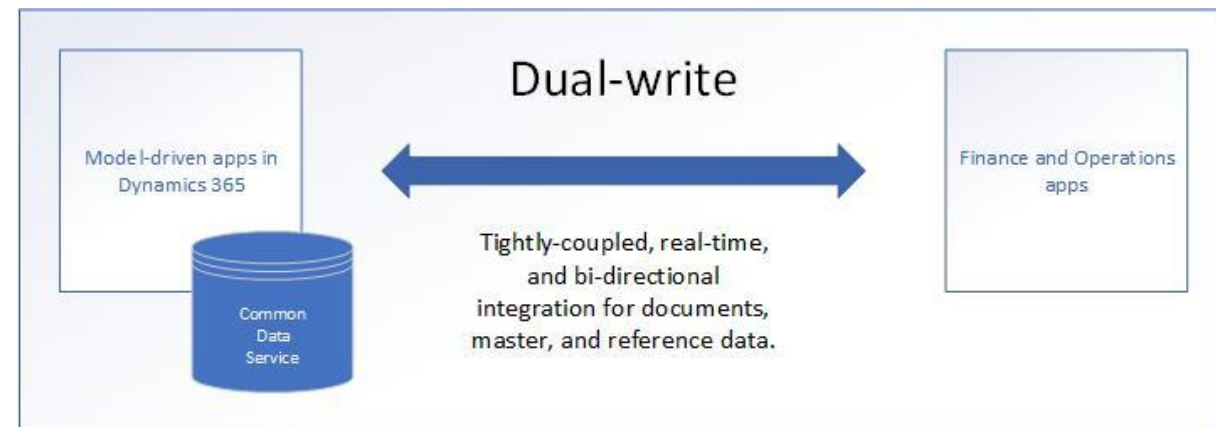

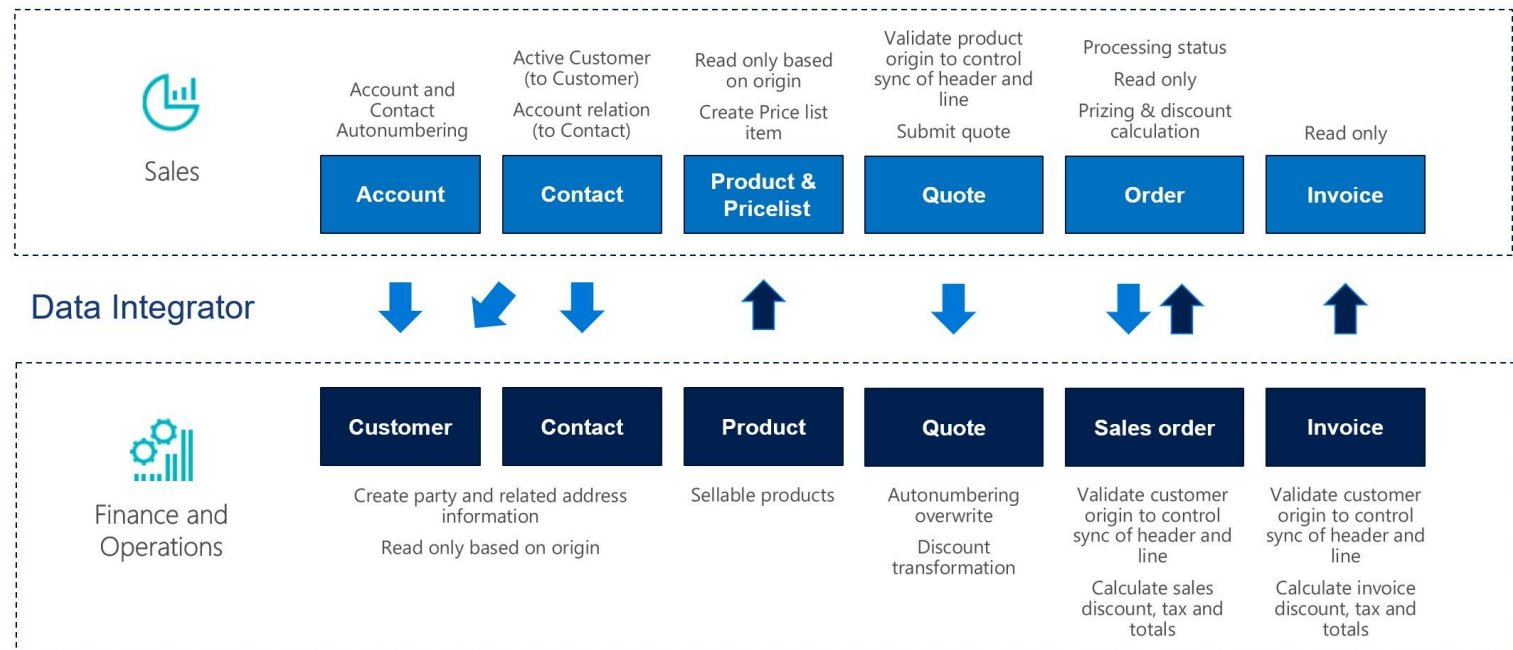

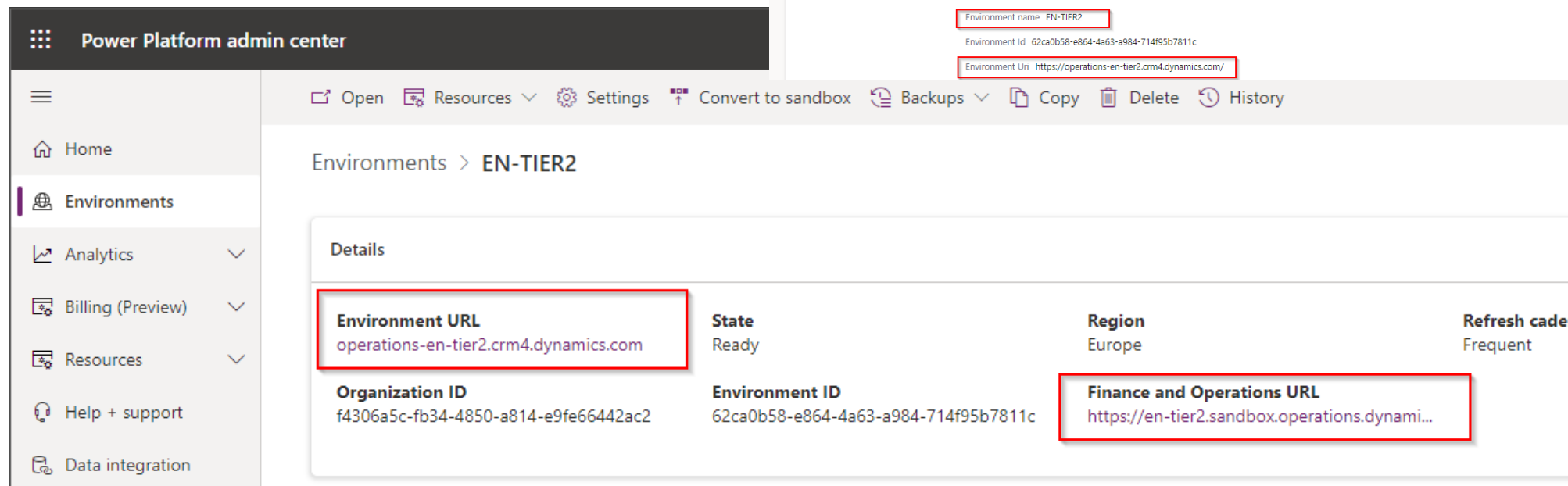

- All Micro Service Add-ins depend on DataVerse
- Data Events and other dependencies

# Lessons Learned

- Initial Sync and continuous sync does not work the same
- Beware of the dependencies
- Customizations make things ALOT harder
- The address structure in CRM and FnO is VERY different (DirPartyTable is no party)
- The FnO UI is not FnO
- Lifecycle Management

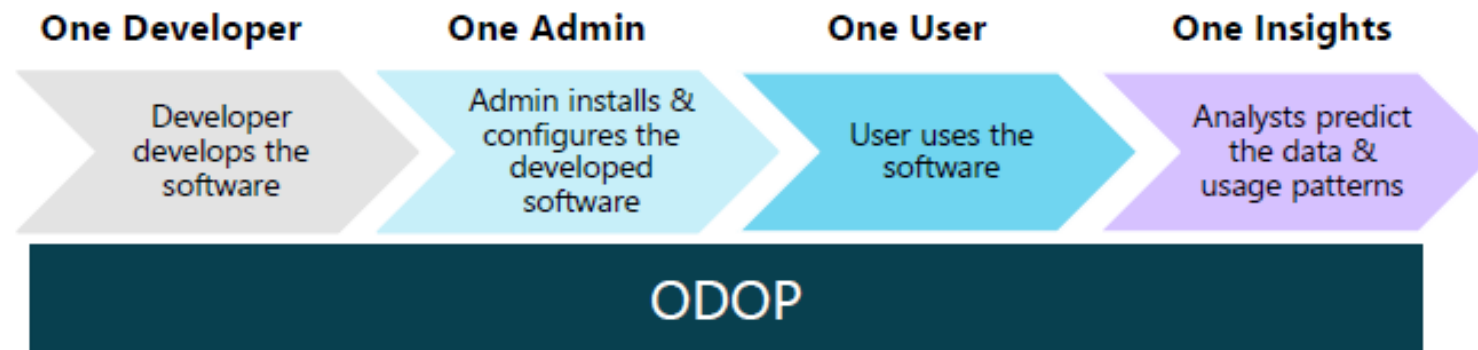

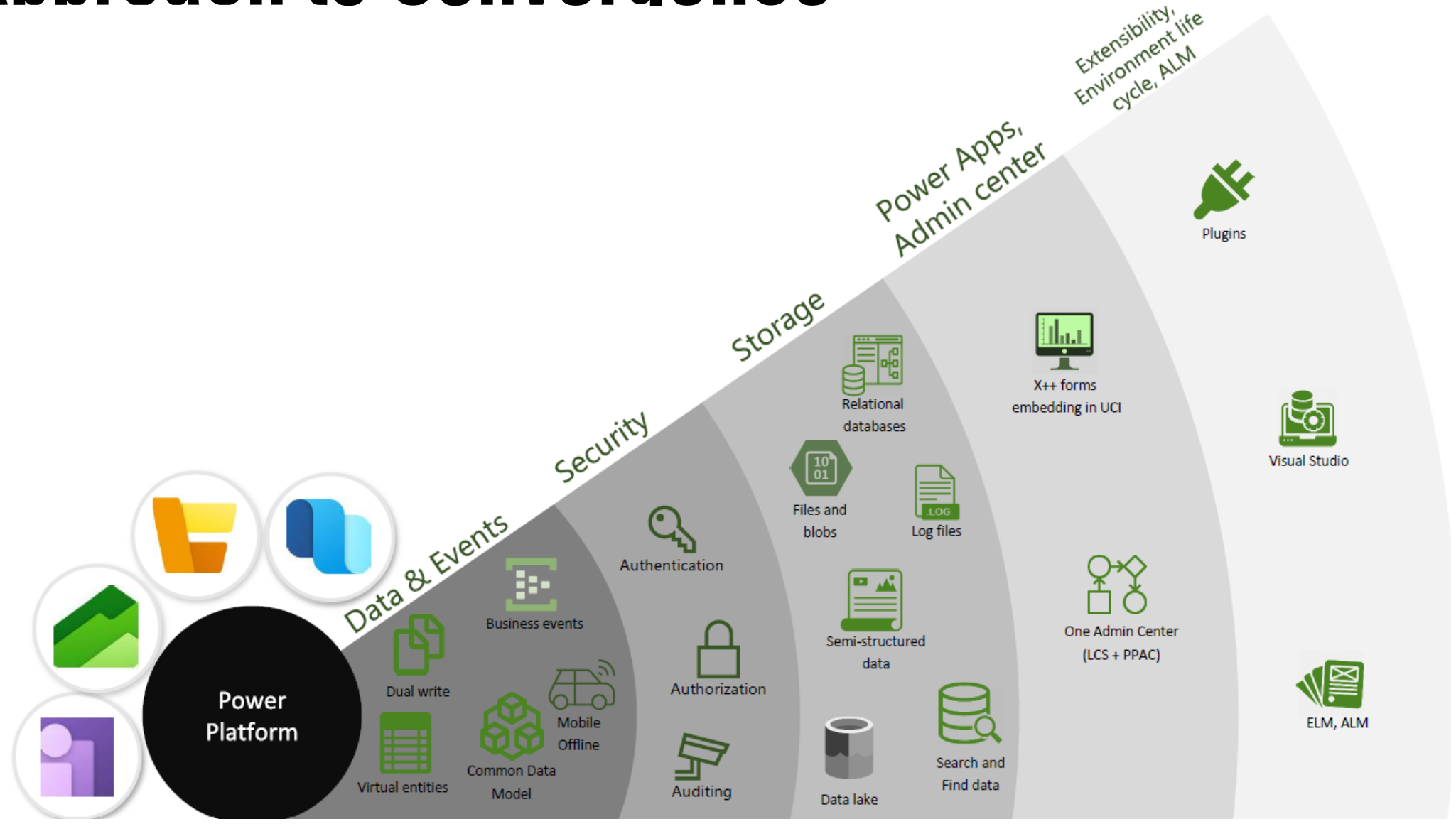

# Approach to Convergence



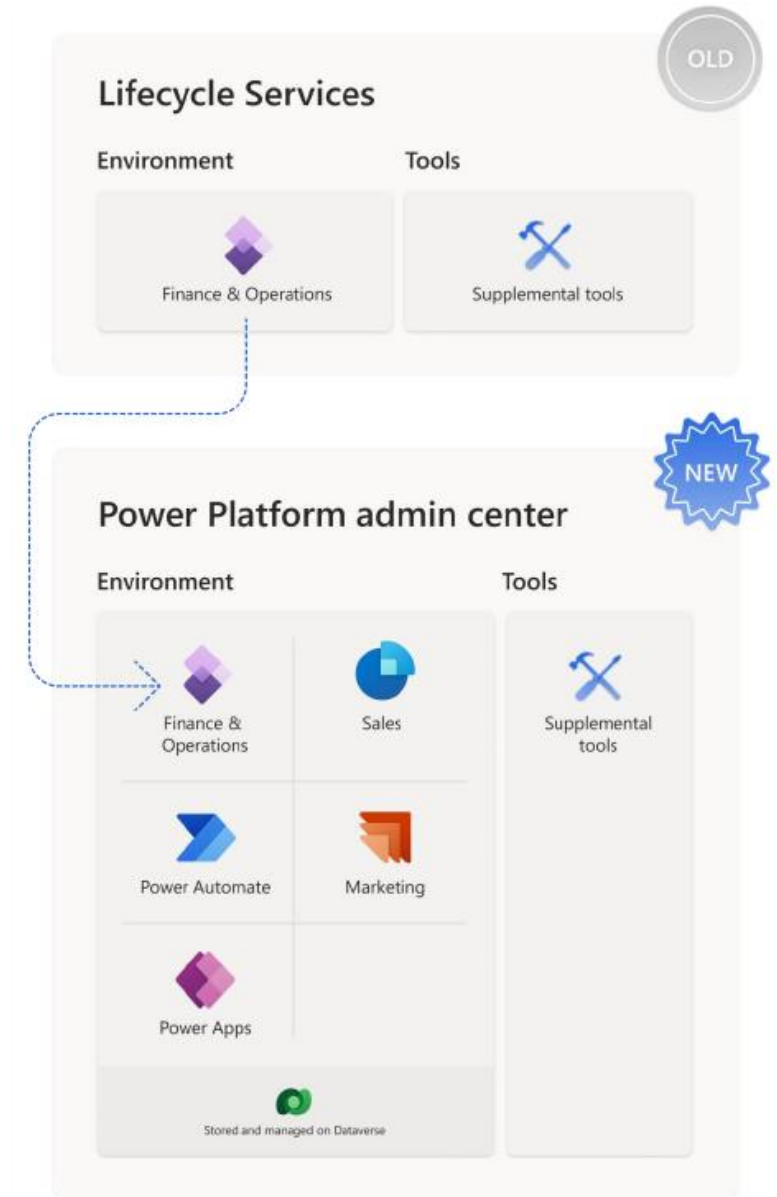
# One Dynamics One Platform

## One Admin Experience

- F&O as an app, not an environment
- Support for unified ALM operations such as Copy/Backup/Restore
- Available in Power Platform Admin Center as well as Power Platform API
- Deployed on an entirely new stack within Dataverse



- Transparent admin experience across D365 apps
- Less tools to understand
- Less manual work
- More admin capabilities to utilize

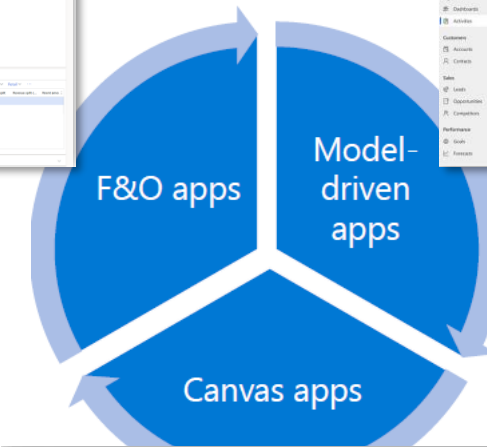
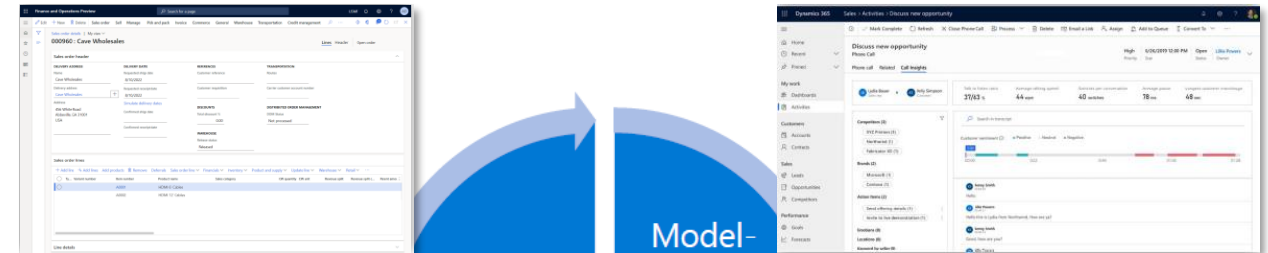


# One Dynamics One Platform

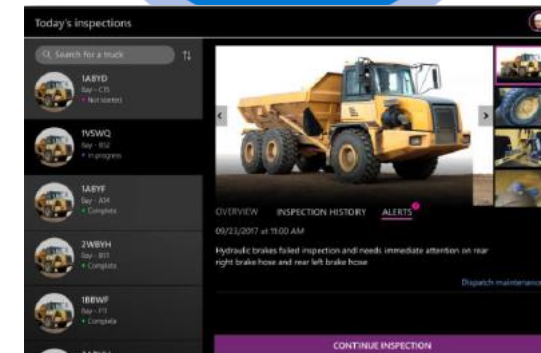
## One User Experience



- The aim is to provide a consistent user experience across D365- & PP apps
- Unlock “mix-and-match” possibilities by embedding apps
  - Canvas apps embedded in F&O
  - Model-drive apps embedded in F&O
  - F&O pages embedded in model-driven apps



- Increase end-user experience
- End-user adoption
- Limit complexity & integration needs by embedding apps

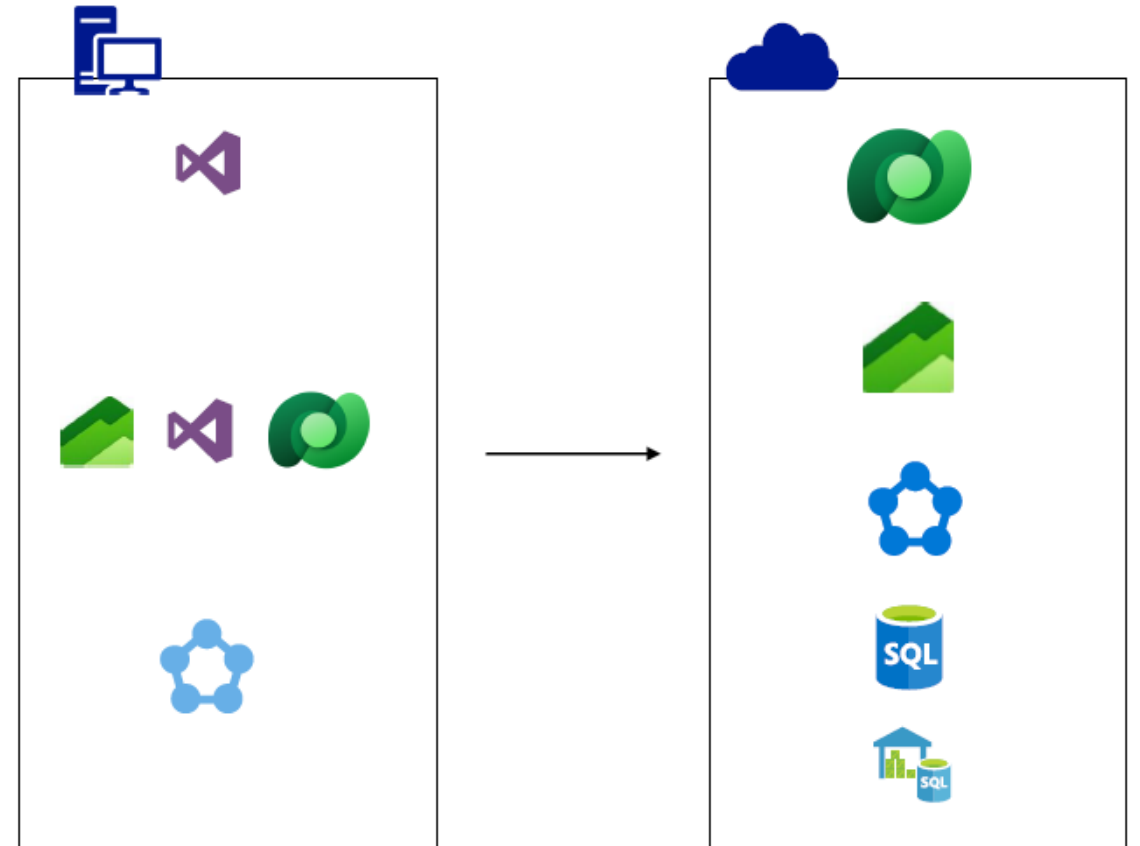


# One Dynamics One Platform

## One Developer Experience

- Dataverse/Power Platform/CE/F&O connected and preconfigured
- Dev environments provisioned from PPAC
- Runs on the same Service Fabric infrastructure
- Online development instead of local VHD

- Less time to prepare and maintain Dev machines
- Less time for integrated CE / F&O development
- All apps provisioned from one experience (PPAC)



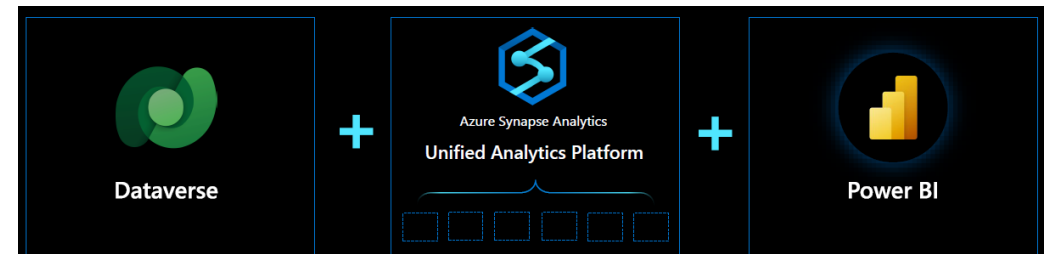
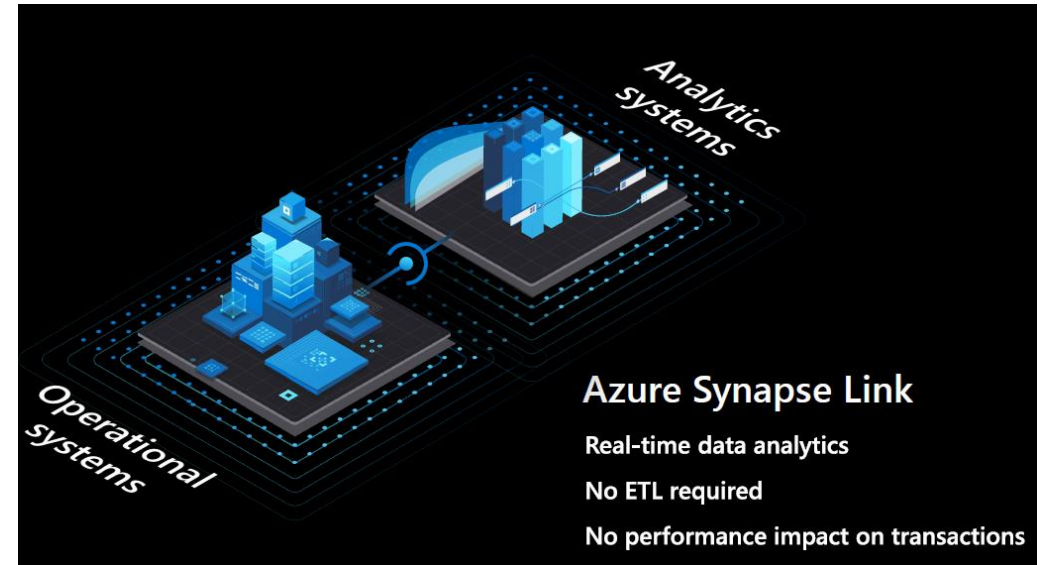
# One Dynamics One Platform

## One Insights Experience

- One integrated experience – Export to Data lake using Synapse Link for Dataverse
- Launch Synapse from Dataverse or F&O
- Dynamics metadata in Synapse
- Save data as parquet for better performance



- Unified experience independent of app
- Easier to create views and unlock insights
- Better performance
